Anne Marie Varney passed away on March 30, 2015. It's a tragedy we do not want any other family to experience. She was a beautiful person inside and out, she would help anyone. If you needed a hug, she would hug you and not let go. Our goal is to help those that need that one extra hug during their darkest times. Through these blankets, we want to provide those hugs, over and over again. Annie left behind the three most amazing girls, Angela (19), Christina (17) and Mia (8). These three girls are on a mission to help save others.

Since the launch date of September 30th, 2015, Annie's Kindness Blankets has delivered ~1,700 blankets to various hospitals/organizations/individuals. We concentrate mainly in Boston and surrounding areas, but we have also extended across the U.S. and the globe. We also have 3 satellite sites that have started to help make and deliver blankets in Nantucket, MA, North Carolina and Wisconsin. Amazing!
